Direct Donation Plan

The Direct Donation Plan helps you in several ways:

- It saves time and money – fewer checks to write, no stamps or envelopes to use
- It helps you meet your commitment in a convenient and timely manner, even when you are on vacation or out of town
- It is easy to sign-up, easy to change, easy to cancel

Here is how the Direct Donation Plan works:

- You authorize regularly scheduled donations to be made from your checking or savings account
- Donations are automatically deducted the 20th of the month, or the following business day if the 20th falls on the weekend or holiday
- The donation will appear on your bank statement
- You may change the amount or cancel at any time; just notify us
- The Direct Donation Plan is dependable, flexible, convenient, and easy

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: If I use Direct Donations for my weekly giving, how can I give to special collections?

A: If you wish to contribute to special collections, you can either use the pew envelopes or write a personal check. In either case your contribution will be credited to you.

Q: How do I change the amount of my donation once it begins?

A: Simply contact the parish bookkeeper to make any adjustment.

Q: At the end of the year will I still receive a contribution statement?

A: Yes, you will receive a contribution statement by the end of January.
